3RD ANNUAL DI FIORE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY FOR AREA RESIDENTS

It has been 3 years since lifetime Taylor Street area resident **Antoinette "Toni" Di Fiore** (nee Arpino) passed away. With her husband of 49 years, James "Jimmy", Mrs. Di Fiore lived two blocks from where she was born, in the same building with cousin Barry Dalesandro, husband of the late Suzanne, and across the street from her sister-in-law Peachie Basile.

"While Toni and Jimmy never had children, Toni was extremely generous to her nieces and nephews and even their children," said her nephew, Vincent Arpino. "Her generosity carried over to the neighborhood, where many of her close friends became 'cousins.'

A life-long member of The Shrine of Our Lady of Pompeii, she frequently sat in the back row. "There was nothing she loved more than St. Joseph's Day, which included her hand-painted St. Joseph statues, coveted items during the fund-raising auctions," Arpino said.

"Toni's legacy is not so much her personal feats or accomplishments, but it is what she did and contributed to the lives of the people that she came in contact with, making others better," Arpino said. "May Toni be smiling down upon the neighborhood and resting in peace.

In honor of Toni, her nephew, Vincent Arpino, has started an annual **\$1,000.00 scholarship** to be awarded to a **neighborhood resident** attending a **Catholic high school**, in

the Chicagoland area, so that Toni's spirit lives on.

The scholarship winner will be announced at the 11 a.m. Mass, **Sunday, March 17**, the Feast of St. Joseph. ****Scholarship winner is expected to attend this mass to receive the scholarship.**
